### Marina Lighthouse

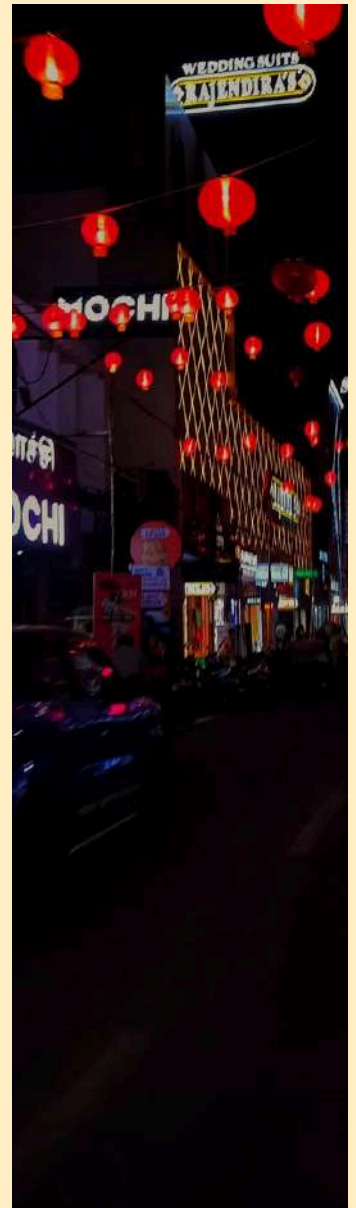
